Get to know the sources of the words/ phrases

For Basic Words (CEFR proficiency levels of B1 and below) to be shown, 'Turn On' this button. However, we do not recommend this and instead ask you to focus on the 'Essential' and 'Uncategorised' words/ phrases suggested.

Click on any word/ phrase you wish to contextually practice

Once you practice, that word will not be seen in this card of 5. It will go into 'Words Practiced' or 'Phrases Practiced' section

Click 'Next' button only after all 5 words/ phrases you see in the card are known to you

These will go into the 'Words I know' and 'Phrases I know' sections.



Correct Response! 🎉

Option A correctly uses 'delegate' in the context of assigning or entrusting authority or tasks to others, which fits well with the idea of giving more autonomy to local councils. The other options misuse the word by placing it in contexts that do not relate to this meaning.




